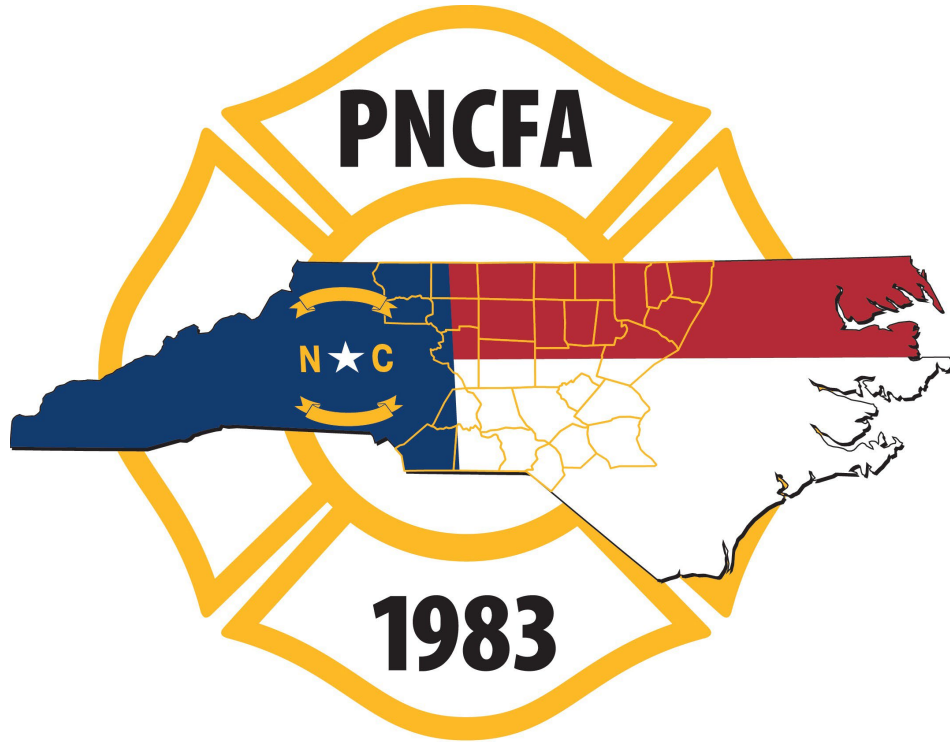

Scholarship Overview

The Piedmont North Carolina Firefighters' Association (PNCFA) will sponsor the following scholarship.

One Firefighter Associate's Degree scholarship valued at \$2,500 will be awarded annually to a successful applicant in the Piedmont voting district.

Scholarship applicants that are awarded a PNCFA scholarship are ineligible to apply for another PNCFA scholarship in future years.

Overview of Scholarship Rules

The PNCFA Scholarship Administration Policies direct all aspects of the PNCFA Scholarship Program.

The applicant must be a member of the PNCFA and an active NCSFA rostered firefighter.

The applicants fire department must be located within the boundaries of the Piedmont voting district.

All required information shall be filled out on the scholarship application form. Areas that do not apply should be marked N/A. The applicant will be disqualified if any applicant information is missing.

Not submitting supporting documentation may result in a disqualification of the entire application.

All applicants who are awarded a scholarship must attend a regionally accredited college/university that is recognized by the US Department of Education.

Applications are scored based on the criteria submitted on the application. No other factors shall be considered, and the members of the scholarship review committee will independently review all information submitted with the application.

Recipients of the Firefighter Associate's Degree Scholarship must seek a degree in a field directly related to the fire service. These degrees include Business Administration, Public Administration, Fire Science, Fire Administration, Emergency Management, Fire Engineering, Fire Protection, and Fire Investigation.

Application Process Instructions

All submissions must be received by US mail by the due date.

Application packages must contain all required documentation. Those missing the required documentation will be disqualified.

An individual may only apply for one scholarship.
