

#### **Scholarship Policy Overview**

The Piedmont North Carolina Firefighters' Association (PNCFA) will sponsor the following scholarship.

One High School Graduate Bachelor's Degree scholarships valued at \$2,500 will be awarded annually to a successful applicant.

<u>Scholarship applicants that are awarded a PNCFA scholarship are ineligible to apply for another PNCFA scholarship in future years.</u>

#### **Overview of Scholarship Rules**

The PNCFA Board Policy Manual directs all aspects of the PNCFA Scholarship Program.

The High School Graduate Bachelor's Scholarship application is open to any graduating high school senior, who is the dependent child of an active firefighter that is a member of the NCSFA, or a junior firefighter that is rostered on a NCSFA member fire department.

The parent of the graduating high school student applicant or a junior firefighter scholarship applicant, must serve in a fire department that is located within the boundaries of the PNCFA voting district.

All required information shall be completed on the scholarship application form and supporting documents must be submitted as a complete package. Areas of the application that do not apply must be indicated by inserting N/A.

All applicants who are awarded a scholarship must attend a regionally accredited college or university that is recognized by the US Department of Education.

All applications are evaluated based on the information completed and submitted with the application. No other factors shall be considered, and the members of the scholarship review committee will independently review all information submitted with the application.

Note: The information provided on the scholarship application is that of the student applicant and not the parent of the student.

#### **Application Process Instructions**

All applications must be postmarked no later than March 31.

Application packages must contain all required documentation. Those missing the required documentation will be disqualified.

The student applicant may only submit one scholarship application.
